



# THE RIGHT TO UNIVERSITY STUDY (DSU) ISTITUTO SECOLI - MILAN



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## 1) THE RIGHT TO UNIVERSITY STUDY

The Right to University Studies is based on Articles 3 and 34 of the Constitution and determines the possibility for the able and deserving, even those without financial means, to reach the highest levels of studies.

The regional law (l.r.) Lombardy 13/12/2004 no. 33 regulates the system of interventions aimed at making the Right to University Study effective in the Institutions of High Artistic and Musical Education (AFAM).

The benefits for students enrolled in a Level I Academic Diploma course at Istituto Secoli consist in the awarding of study grants, assigned through a competition announced in compliance with Lombardy Regional Law no. 33 of 13 December 2004 and article no. 3 of the Prime Ministerial Decree (Prime Ministerial Decree) of 9 April 2001, implementing article no. 4 of Law no. 390 of 2 December 1991, also in light of Legislative Decree no. 109 of 31 March 1998, regulating the Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE) as a parameter for assessing the economic conditions of applicants for study grants, and other applicable laws and regulations, and in light of the provisions of the law of 31 March 1998 no. 109, regulating the Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE) as a parameter for assessing the economic conditions of applicants for study grants. 109, regulating the Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE) as a parameter for evaluating the economic conditions of applicants for study grants, and further applicable laws and regulations, including the resolution of the Regional Council (d.G.r. ) of the Lombardy Region no. XII/6298 of 15/06/2026 concerning «*Determinations regarding the criteria and funding forecasts for the allocation of competitive benefits for the right to university study - academic year 2026-2027*».

In order to guarantee the Right to University Studies, Istituto Secoli coordinates, organises and provides for the benefit of those eligible for:

- a) interventions and services aimed at implementing the Right to University Studies as provided for by Lombardy Regional Law no. 33 of 13/12/2004;
- b) develops and proposes additional interventions and services to facilitate participation in its courses of study.

In addition, Istituto Secoli promotes all interventions that contribute to improving living and learning conditions.

In addition to scholarships under Regional Law No. 33/2004, these interventions also concern the following services:

- *Library - Material Library* service;
- cultural and socialisation activities;
- didactic tutors;
- job orientation/work placement service;
- educational support office.

## 2) WHO CAN BE GRANTED THE SCHOLARSHIP

The following are eligible to apply for a scholarship

- Italian citizens;
- citizens of European Union Member States;
- citizens of States not belonging to the European Union (d.p.r. 31/08/1999, no. 394 inter alia art. no. 44 bis, implementing d.lgs. 25/07/1998, no. 286 as well as d.p.r. 31/08/1999, no. 394, art. no. 46 paragraph 5);

in possession of the following requirements:

- being a student, admitted or enrolled<sup>1</sup> in the academic year 2026/2027, to a Level I Academic Diploma course activated by Istituto Secoli at its Milan site;
- meet the economic and merit requirements, as set out in point 4 below.

The Scholarship may be granted to students enrolled in Academic Diploma Level I courses who attend for the first time each year of the course envisaged by the didactic system, for a period equal to seven semesters starting from the year of first absolute enrolment.

<sup>1</sup> Access to scholarships and the use of benefits and services pertaining to the Right to University Study is reserved for students regularly enrolled for the 2026/2027 academic year.

Please note that in order to be 'regularly enrolled', interested parties must be in order with their academic requirements and administrative position (payment of registration and tuition fees) by the following dates

attendance fees) by the following dates

- 05.10.2026 - students enrolled in the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the course

Students who are not in order by the above-mentioned date will therefore not be considered eligible for the provisional ranking for access to the Scholarships.



Following the entry into force of Law No. 33 of 12 April 2022, students are permitted to enroll simultaneously in two degree programmes, subject to compliance with the conditions established by the applicable regulations. Pursuant to Article 3 of the same law, students enrolled in two study programmes at the same time may benefit from student welfare services and financial aid measures for one enrolment only, which must be designated by the student.

Students must therefore declare in their Scholarship application any concurrent enrolment (or intention to enrol, including at another university or AFAM institution) and specify which enrolment they wish to use for the purposes of accessing Student Welfare Services and Financial Aid.

Failure to declare, or the submission of false information regarding, concurrent enrolment will result in the revocation of any Scholarship awarded or paid and may lead to the application of the sanctions provided for under the applicable legislation.

Pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 3, of Ministerial Decree No. 1320/2021, students enrolled simultaneously in more than one study programme are entitled to a 20% increase in the Scholarship amount, provided that they continue to satisfy the academic merit requirements for the entire duration of the programmes.

The competition for the awarding of Scholarships is not open, under penalty of exclusion, to students enrolled in courses at Istituto Secoli in the 2026/2027 academic year who:

- have previously obtained, in Italy or abroad, degrees at a level equal to, equivalent to or higher than the course of study for which benefits and services are requested for the 2026/2027 academic year;
- benefit or have already benefited - even partially - for the same year of the course from a study grant (or similar form of economic aid related to the consideration of income conditions or study results or both) granted by Istituto Secoli or other public or private bodies;
- enrolling at Istituto Secoli after having dropped out of studies, forfeiture, transfer, etc. at Istituto Secoli or another university/academy, regardless of how much time has elapsed since their previous enrolment;
- are enrolled at a foreign university and are admitted to attend courses at Istituto Secoli under international exchange agreements (Erasmus / Exchange).

NB: Please note the clarifications in footnote 1 of this notice.

### 3) ALLOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

For the academic year 2026/2027 Istituto Secoli, on the basis of the appropriation allocated by d.G.r. no. XII/6298 of 16/06/2026, **is putting up for competition € 16,005.96 in scholarships** in addition to any future contributions from Regione Lombardia.

### 4) REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCESS TO THE SCHOLARSHIP RANKINGS

#### 4.1) Merit requirements

To access the final rankings, applicants must:

#### a. First-year students - Level I Academic Diploma Course:

- be duly enrolled for the academic year 2026/2027 for the first time in the first year of a Level I Academic Diploma course, activated by Istituto Secoli, on 05/10/2026;
- have obtained a high school graduation mark of no less than 80/100<sup>2</sup>;
- meet the economic requirements set out in section 4.2 (*"Requirements concerning economic conditions"*).

In addition, confirmation of benefits, as specified in Section 10 (*'ALLOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND TERMS OF PAYMENT; CASES OF REVOCATION'*), is subject to the achievement by 10/08/2027 of a minimum number of 40 credits.

NB:

- With regard to the terms of payment and withdrawal from the benefit, please refer to point 10 below;
- Cases of incompatibility and disqualification are governed by Section 11 below.

**b. Second- and third-year students - Level I Academic Diploma Course:**

- be duly registered<sup>3</sup> for the 2026/2027 academic year in the second or third year of a Level I Academic Diploma course, activated by Istituto Secoli, on 05/10/2026;
- have been achieved by 10/08/2026:
  - **at least 40 credits** (for students enrolled in the second year)
  - **at least 100 credits** (for students enrolled in the third year)
- meet the economic requirements set out in section 4.2 (*"Requirements concerning economic conditions"*).

In addition, confirmation of benefits, as specified in Section 10 ('*ALLOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND TERMS OF PAYMENT; CASES OF REVOCATION*'), is subject to the achievement by 10/08/2027 of a minimum number of:

- **100 credits** (for students enrolled in the second year)
- **160 credits** (for students enrolled in the third year)

NB:

- with regard to the terms of payment and withdrawal from the benefit, please refer to point 10 below;
- cases of incompatibility and disqualification are governed by Section 11 below.

**c. Students with disabilities:**

For students with a disability rating of over 66% or with a recognised handicap pursuant to art. no. 3 paragraph 1 Law 104/92, enrolled for the first time in the first year of Level I Academic Diploma courses, the merit requirements may be redefined, based on the type of handicap, which may differ up to a maximum of 40%. The merit requirements will be established by a special internal commission of the Istituto Secoli.

**d. To all students:**

When filling out the application, you will be asked to indicate the number of credits you have earned and their weighted average. These values are to be understood as follows:

- Number of credits: it is required to declare the credits acquired, deriving from examinations taken and duly recorded from the start of the career (for the current level of studies) and by 10/08/2026. On the other hand, credits deriving from examinations not included in the ordinary study plan or acquired in previous academic careers and not validated in the study plan cannot be considered valid.
- Weighted average: to calculate the weighted average, each exam grade must be multiplied by its credit value. The sum of these results is then divided by the total number of credits considered. Exams that are not graded on a scale out of 30 are not included. A grade of 30 "cum laude" (30 e lode) is counted as 30.

/ EXAMPLE:

Exam 1: grade 26/30, value 9 credits

Exam 2: grade 30/30, value 12 credits

Exam 3: grade 18/30, value 9 credits

Exam 4: approved grade (e.g. language proficiency), value 3 credits

Total credits held: 33 credits

Total credits to be taken into account for weighted average: 30 credits

Weighted average calculation:

$26 \times 9 = 234$

$30 \times 12 = 360$

$18 \times 9 = 162$

<b>Totale: 756</b>

Weighted average:  $756/30 = 25,20$

#### e. Bonus:

If the person concerned has not obtained the minimum number of credits required, he may use a bonus in addition to the credits actually obtained in the following way, differentiated according to the year of enrolment in which the student intends to use it:

- 5 credits, if used for the first time to obtain benefits for the second year;
- 12 credits, if used for the first time to obtain benefits for the third year

The bonus may only be used once and cannot be accumulated. The portion of the bonus not used in the academic year in question may be used in subsequent years.

The bonus accrued and not used during the Level I Academic Diploma may be used if the student enrolls in Level II Academic Diploma courses.

#### 4.2) Requirements concerning economic conditions

The economic conditions of the family unit of the student applying for the study grant are identified on the basis of the Indicatore della Situazione Economica Equivalente per le prestazioni del Diritto allo Studio Universitario (ISEE Universitario).

The University ISEE must contain, under penalty of inadmissibility of the application, the wording “*si applica alle prestazioni agevolate per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario in favore di <codice fiscale studente>*” (“*applies to subsidised benefits for the Right to University Studies in favour of <student tax code>*.”) and do not report *Omissioni/Difformità (Omissions/Difformities)*.

The University ISEE is a certificate that any Italian citizen can obtain:

- on their own, through the appropriate procedure on the INPS website
- at the appropriate entities (INPS offices, municipalities, CAF)

The certificate is issued on the basis of the data declared in the Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica (DSU), a self-certification under Presidential Decree 445/2000: whoever signs the DSU is civilly, criminally and administratively responsible for the correctness and completeness of the data it contains. By signing it, the interested party declares that he/she is aware of the civil, criminal and administrative consequences that the law attaches to false or otherwise misleading declarations.

The University ISEE must be calculated using the economic situation indicator (given by the sum of the incomes received by the members of the person's household plus 20% of the asset values) related to the number of household members (equivalence scale).

For the 2026/2027 academic year, the income to be referred to is that of the 2024 calendar year, the assets (both real estate and movable property) that of 31/12/2025.

In order to be considered to meet the income requirement for applying for a study grant, students must have a University ISEE whose:

- *University Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE)* not exceeding € 26,887.93.
- *Indicator of Equivalent Financial Situation (ISPE)*, calculated by the managing bodies and corresponding to ISP / Scale of equivalence, as per Section I Modalities for calculating ordinary ISEE of the attestation for benefits related to university study, does not exceed € 58,452.06.

The two limits indicated must both be complied with at the same time; exceeding even only one of them determines the non-possession of the economic requirement and the ineligibility of the person concerned for the benefit.

#### UNIVERSITY ISEE

The University ISEE refers to the reference household of the person concerned, with these clarifications:

- STUDENT LIVING WITH BOTH PARENTS: standard family unit;
- INDEPENDENT STUDENT\*: the household of reference for the ISEE is that of the student and does not take the family of origin into account;
- NON AUTONOMOUS STUDENT or LIVING WITH ONLY ONE PARENT:
  - a. Married and cohabiting parents: the reference household for ISEE is made up of the household of origin and the student himself.
  - b. Parents NOT married and not cohabiting with each other:
    - If the non-cohabiting parent pays maintenance to the child, they are not counted in the household;
    - if the non-cohabiting parent is not married and/or has no children with a person other than the other parent, they are considered part of the household; he/she may declare their income in the DSU or submit their own ISEE, the details of which must be indicated in the ISEE form for university benefits;
    - if the non-cohabiting parent is married and/or has children with a person other than the other parent, they must submit their own ISEE whose details must be indicated on the ISEE form for university benefits.



### \*INDEPENDENT STUDENT

In the case of an 'independent' student, as defined in accordance with the regulations in force (cf. d.p.c.m. 09/04/2001 and d.p.c.m. 159 of 05/12/2013), the income will not be supplemented with that of the student's original household.

The student is defined as 'independent' when all the requirements of the regulations in force are met and, in particular, the following:

1. the student must have had a residence separate and different from that of their family of origin for at least two years from the date of submission of the single substitute declaration relating to their household;
2. the student's residence must not be in a property owned or usufructed by the family of origin or, in any case, by one of its members (by way of clarification, the student is not independent even if he or she co-owns the accommodation with at least one member of the family of origin or if at least one member holds another right in rem or a personal right of enjoyment over the accommodation);
3. presence of an adequate income capacity, defined by the ministerial decree referred to in Article no. 7, paragraph 7, of Legislative Decree no. 68 of 29/03/2012, meaning in particular that tax-declared income from employment or assimilated employment for at least two years must be demonstrated, not less than € 9,000.00 with reference to a family unit of one person, it being understood that the work must not be performed on the payroll of a family member.

In the absence of one or more requirements, in order to adequately take into account the individuals who bear the burden of supporting the student, the student's household, as certified by the registry office, will be integrated with that of the family of origin, also integrating their respective incomes.

If the independent student is registered as living with another person, the student's income and that of the person with whom he is living with must be taken into account, even if there are no family ties.

*Married student* in accordance with current provisions (d.p.c.m. 09/04/2001), the condition of independent student is also applicable in the case of a married student only if the student meets the residency requirement indicated above and if, also taking into account the spouse's income, the minimum income requirement of € 9,000.00 is met.

NB:  
Procedure to be followed to obtain the integrated ISEE: Due to technical issues with the INPS computer system, students who must integrate their own household with that of their parents must ensure that, at the time of requesting their ISEE, their parents are already in possession of a valid ISEE certificate (otherwise INPS will not be able to calculate the cumulative ISEE). Once the ISEE has been obtained, the parents must inform the student of the protocol number of their ISEE and the student must arrange for it to be inserted in the appropriate field of picture D of their DSU. In this way, INPS will provide for the integration of the student's ISEE with that of the parents only for the purpose of calculating the university ISEE.

### CURRENT ISEE

Pursuant to Article no. 9 of Prime Ministerial Decree 159/2013, the current ISEE may be requested when, despite already having a valid ordinary ISEE, there is a change in the employment situation or an interruption of social security, welfare and allowance treatments that are not included in the total income (declared for IRPEF purposes) for one or more members of the household; or, again, when there is a decrease in the overall income capacity of the household of more than 25%. For further information, please refer to Article no. 9 of Prime Ministerial Decree 159/2013 and to the remaining provisions of the law or regulations in force.

### FOREIGN STUDENTS - EQUIVALENT ISEEU-ISPEU

The economic status of foreign students or Italian students living abroad is defined on the basis of Article no. 8, paragraph 5, of Prime Ministerial Decree 159/2013, subject to different provisions issued at national level.

The economic and asset status of foreign students who are not citizens of European Union member states is assessed in accordance with the procedures laid down by legislative decree no. 286 of 25/07/1998 (art. no. 4, paragraphs 3 and 39) and by presidential decree no. 394 of 31/08/1999 (art. no. 46, paragraph 5).

To facilitate the issuance of the **Equivalent ISEEU-ISPEU certificate**, international students may request certification at the following tax assistance center (CAAF) partnered with Istituto Secoli:

For the purpose of determining the Equivalent ISEEU, the student is required to submit the following documentation:

1. a **valid identity document or passport**, including a photograph and personal details;
2. **Italian tax code** (codice fiscale);
3. **student ID number** assigned by Istituto Secoli;
4. **composition of the student's foreign household**, updated at the time of the application;
5. **income of each household member**, referring to the second year prior to the application:
  - if one or more household members aged 18 or over did not receive any income, a declaration confirming this must be provided;
6. **documentation regarding real estate and land** owned by the household as of December 31 of the second year prior to the application, specifying the surface area in square meters and issued by a competent public authority:
  - in the absence of real estate, a certificate confirming the lack of property ownership must be submitted for each household member aged 18 or over;
7. **movable assets** of the household as of December 31 of the second year prior to the application, including securities, dividends, shareholdings, and company equity.

Additional Information:

- Any **income or assets held in Italy** must also be declared.
- If the student does **not meet the minimum income requirement** set by ISEE regulations to be considered financially independent, they will be assessed based on their **original household**. In this case, if the household's income and assets are located abroad, the student must submit the **Equivalent ISEEU**.

All documents must be:

- **Issued by the competent authorities** of the foreign country where the income and assets were produced;
- **Legalized by the Italian diplomatic or consular authorities** in the country of origin;
- **Accompanied by an official Italian translation**, faithful to the original, and certified by:
  - the relevant Italian diplomatic or consular authority
  - or*
  - an official translator.

COUNTRIES EXEMPTED FROM LEGALISATION (regardless of place of issue):

Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain (extended to Isle of Man), Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malta, Netherlands (extended to Netherlands Antilles and Aruba), Norway, Poland, Portugal, San Marino, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland, Turkey.

COUNTRIES WHOSE DOCUMENTATION PROVIDES FOR EXEMPTION FROM THE CONSULAR/DIPLOMATIC STAMP, BUT FOR WHICH AN APOSTILLE STAMP IS REQUIRED:

Monaco, Reunion, Republic of Korea (formerly South Korea), Romania, Russia, Saint Christopher and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Helena, Serbia-Montenegro, Seychelles, Suriname, Sweden, Swaziland, United States of America, South Africa, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Ukraine, Vanuatu, Venezuela, British Virgin Islands.

FOREIGN STUDENTS FROM PARTICULARLY POOR COUNTRIES ARE CONSIDERED CITIZENS OF:

Afghanistan, Angola, Bangladesh, Benin, Bhutan, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cambodia, Cape Verde, Chad, Comoros, North Korea, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ivory Coast, Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Equatorial Guinea, Haiti, Kenya, Kiribati, Lao Peoplès Dem. Rep., Laos, Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Maldives, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nepal, Niger, Nigeria, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Central African Republic, Rwanda, Samoa, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Solomon Islands, Somalia, Sudan, Tajikistan, Tanzania, Timor Leste, Togo, Tuvalu, Uganda, Uzbekistan, Vanatu, Vietnam, Yemen, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

The assessment of the economic condition of students from the above-mentioned particularly poor countries is carried out on the basis of a certification issued by the Italian Representation in the country of origin of the interested party, stating that the student does not belong to a family known to have a high income. This certification may also be issued by the foreign university of enrolment of the interested party, linked by agreements or conventions with Italian universities or bodies authorised to provide the financial coverage guarantee referred to in the current provisions on the enrolment of foreign students in Italian universities. In the latter case, the certifying body undertakes to return the grant on behalf of the student should it be revoked.



REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA, SWEDEN: for these two countries, signatories of the 1968 London Convention, special provisions apply. Citizens of these two countries are exempt from the obligation to legalise documents issued only and exclusively by diplomatic and consular authorities (present on Italian territory).

ALBANIA: as of 01/07/2011, Albanian documents to be presented in Italy must no longer be legalised in advance by the Italian diplomatic-consular Representations in Albania, but must be stamped with an Apostille by the Albanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Please refer to the careful examination of the websites of the Italian Embassy in Tirana (<http://www.ambtirana.esteri.it>) and of the Consulates in Shkodra (<http://www.consitalia-scutari.org>) and Vlora (<http://www.consvalona.esteri.it>) and to the information that the interested party can obtain from those bodies for detailed information on the compulsory procedure to be followed.

STATELESS STUDENTS OR POLITICAL REFUGEES:

Stateless students or political refugees must enclose with their application the official certificate of statelessness or political refugee status issued by the Italian Ministry of the Interior or the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees and Refugees - Office for Italy (UNHCR Italy).

THE DSU OFFICE OF THE SECOLI INSTITUTE DOES NOT ACCEPT OR RECEIVE ANY DOCUMENTATION NECESSARY, OR PROPEDEUTICAL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FULFILLING INTO THE ISEE University/ISEEU-ISPEU FORM.

That documentation must therefore be delivered, personally by the interested party, only and exclusively to INPS or to the CAFs located throughout the country. The DSU Office of Istituto Secoli will only and exclusively receive the ISEE model issued by the competent bodies on a definitive basis. Istituto Secoli will not be responsible for flaws and defects attributable to the administrations and bodies responsible for issuing the aforementioned documentation.

## 5) AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS

The amount of the grant is differentiated according to two variants:

- a. the band corresponding to the correct ISEE University of the household;
- b. the different geographical origin of the student.

a. Income brackets:

b. Geographical origin:

For the purpose of calculating the amount of the grant, students are classified as follows:

- On-site student: resident in the municipality where the courses attended are based, in a neighbouring municipality or in a municipality classified as an urban area pursuant to Lombardy Regional Law 6/2012 (Art. no. 2, paragraph 3, letter b).
- Commuter student: resident in a municipality other than that of the courses attended, but which nevertheless allows daily travel to the location of the courses attended, taking between 60 and 90 minutes, using public transport.
- Off-campus student<sup>4</sup>: resident in a place that is distant (more than 90 minutes, using public transport) from the location of the course attended and who, for this reason, takes lodgings for a fee<sup>5</sup> near that location, using public residential facilities or other private or institutional lodgings for a period of no less than 10 months within the 2026/2027 academic year (in the absence of this condition, the student is considered a commuter).

N.B. To consult the complete list of municipalities to be considered as in-commuters or commuters, please refer to Annex A - List of municipalities by geographic origin definition (Milan Headquarters).

<sup>4</sup> Art. no. 13 par. 3 of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 09/04/2001 states that non-EU international students are considered "off-campus students" regardless of their place of residence in Italy, except in cases where the student's family resides in Italy. For the purpose of determining the scholarship amount, the accommodation must be for a fee.

<sup>5</sup> The term "for a fee" refers to the existence of a duly registered rental agreement, either in the name of the student or of a parent. Alternatively, for students residing in public or private facilities, it refers to the existence of fiscally valid certification of payment for the accommodation used in the city where the university course takes place. The rental contract or fiscal certification must be submitted no later than December 10, 2026, prior to the publication of the final ranking. Failure to submit this documentation will result in the student being classified as a "commuter."

## 6) SCHOLARSHIP SUPPLEMENTS

### a. Disabled students:

The study grant may be increased up to a maximum of 40% of the amount due, in the case of students with a disability of over 66% and with a handicap recognised pursuant to art. no. 3, subsection 1, law 104/92, depending on the disability suffered by the student, in order to allow the use of prostheses and supports, as well as all interventions that facilitate the use of teaching and studying.

### b. International mobility:

No supplement for international mobility is planned for the academic year 2026/2027.

## 7) PROCEDURES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RANKINGS

The rankings are formulated according to the criteria specified below:

### a. First-year students - Level I Academic Diploma Course:

Each student applying for a study grant is awarded a score relative to the economic situation, formulated on the basis of the family unit's correct *Indicatore della Situazione Economica Equivalente* (ISEE) (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator), related to the limit of € 26,887.93 for a maximum of 1,000 points awarded according to the following formula:

$$1 - (ISEE\ student / 26,887.93) * 1.000$$

The order in the ranking list is determined in descending order of the marks awarded. In the event of a tied score, the grade relating to the qualification prevails, followed by the youngest age.

### b. Second- and third-year students - Level I Academic Diploma Course:

The order of the ranking is determined in descending order by the total score resulting from the sum of the score relating to the number of training credits achieved by 10/08/2026 and the score determined by the average exam grade.

The total attributable points are 1,000 distributed as follows:

- 600 based on the number of training credits acquired;
- 400 based on the average mark of the examinations passed.

In the event of a tie, the student who did not use the bonus prevails in the ranking, followed by the student with the highest income score. In the event of a further tie, the student enrolled in the highest course year prevails, followed by the student with the youngest age.



Students with a disability rating of over 66% and with a recognised disability pursuant to art. no. 3, paragraph 1, l. 104/92, if they meet all the requirements set out in the Notice of Competition, are entitled to the allocation of the Scholarship even in excess of the number of Scholarships available and will therefore be placed at the top of the list and made beneficiaries in any case.

#### MODALITIES FOR CALCULATING SCHOOL MERIT POINTS

- The score for training credits earned by 10/08/2026 is calculated according to the following formulas respectively:

$$(student\ credits - minimum\ credits) * 600 / (maximum\ credits - minimum\ credits)$$

- The score for the average mark of the examinations passed is calculated according to the following formula:

$$(average\ student\ grade - minimum\ mark\ 18/30) * 400 / (maximum\ mark\ 30/30 - minimum\ mark\ 18/30)$$

#### 8) TERMS AND MODALITIES FOR SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION

Applications for admission to the competition must be submitted by and no later than 30/10/2026 by personally delivering the application to the *DSU Office - Istituto Secoli* (by appointment and the date of delivery, which will be stamped on the receipt, will be taken as proof) at the address Viale Vittorio Veneto n. 18/a, 20124 Milan.

All interested parties are required to accompany their applications with these documents in a sealed envelope:

- **MOD7516** form 'Application for admission to the DSU competition' completed and signed on front and back;
- front and back copy of a valid identity document;
- Copy of ISEE University Certificate for subsidised benefits for the right to university study issued in 2026;
- copy of the Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica (DSU) referring to the ISEE 2026 extended version signed by the declarant in all its parts (the Declarant is the person who signs the DSU and who assumes criminal, administrative and civil liability for the correctness and completeness of the data contained therein, pursuant to art. no. 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28/12/2000, for falsity in deeds and mendacious declarations, and that he/she declares that he/she has filled in the relevant forms and that what is expressed in them is true and can be ascertained pursuant to art. no. 43 of the aforementioned Presidential Decree no. 445 of 2000, or at any time documented at the request of the competent administrations).

Further documents, to be sent according to your status, in addition to those indicated above:

- Only for students enrolled in the first year - a.y. 2026/2027: copy of the secondary school diploma or diploma certificate issued by the secondary school (self-declaration is not valid for application purposes).
- Only for students enrolled in the second and third year - a.y. 2026/2027: a copy of the individual study plan complete with the examinations taken as at 10/08/2026 and downloadable from their profile on the Moodle e-learning platform.
- Only for "off-campus" students: A copy of the duly registered rental contract, made out in the name of the student or one of his/her parents, and a copy of the certification relating to the payment of rent. Only this document, if not available on the date of application, may be submitted no later than 10/12/2026 (for details see section 5).
- Only for students with a disability equal to or greater than 66% or a handicap recognised under Art. no. 3, paragraph 1, law 104/92: original or certified copy (also pursuant to art. no. 19 of Presidential Decree 445/2000) of appropriate medical documentation proving the disability.
- Only for students who are nationals of non-EU countries: copy of the valid residence permit or a copy of the receipt for the residence permit application.

NB: Failure to submit a document by the prescribed deadline or the submission of an irregular document will result in the exclusion of the person concerned from the Scholarship competition.



The *DSU Office - Secoli Institute* will assess the correctness and completeness of the documents delivered in a sealed envelope and will send an e-mail to the person concerned confirming receipt of the application and its acceptance or rejection. If within 7 days from the delivery of the documents the interested party does not receive the acknowledgement e-mail, they has the duty to contact the DSU Office of Istituto Secoli at this address:

Interested parties are required to inform Istituto Secoli, promptly and in writing, of any event concerning the grant and each of the prerequisites for obtaining and maintaining it, which occurs after the application is submitted (by way of example only: obtaining a different Scholarship or other financial aid, transfer to another University/Academy, commencement of employment, inability to continue studies, withdrawal of enrolment, change in the marital and economic status of the student and of the persons whose income and assets are to be considered for the purposes of granting the Scholarship, etc. ).

## 9) PUBLICATION OF PROVISIONAL RANKINGS AND POSSIBLE APPEALS

The provisional ranking will be made known to interested parties no earlier than 27/11/2026, through publication on the website [www.secoli.com](http://www.secoli.com).

Applicants who have submitted their applications within the deadlines set out in this notice may be ranked as:

- “eligible” if they meet all requirements;
- “non eligible”, if one or more requirements are missing.

Benefits will only be awarded to “eligible” students according to their position in the ranking list, starting from the highest positions and descending until the available resources are exhausted.

On the basis of the actual allocation of benefits, those concerned may then be:

- “eligible beneficiaries”, i.e. scholarship recipients;
- “eligible non-beneficiaries”, i.e. who meet all the eligibility requirements but are not grant recipients.

The students who are “eligible non-beneficiaries” may be awarded scholarships at a later stage, should further financial resources become available.

Any request for revision of the provisional rankings must be submitted to the competent structure of Istituto Secoli no later than 15 days after the publication of the rankings.

The petition must refer to any evaluations that the person concerned considers erroneous on the part of the Istituto Secoli DSU Office and must be accompanied by suitable documentation to objectively justify the reasons for the petition, without prejudice to the unquestionable sphere of discretionary evaluation also of the revision petition pertaining to Istituto Secoli. The outcome of the revision petitions will be sent by e-mail to the interested parties in the forms envisaged for the publication of the rankings.

Once the procedure regarding the examination of any revision requests submitted has been completed, the final ranking list will be published no earlier than 14/12/2026.

## 10) ALLOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND TERMS OF PAYMENT; CASES OF REVOCATION

### a. First-year students - Level I Academic Diploma Course:

The first instalment of the Scholarship (equal to 50% of the total), **subject to the regular remittance of funds to Istituto Secoli by the Lombardy Region**, will be paid to the eligible beneficiaries (eligible students) by 31/12/2026.

The second instalment of the Scholarship will be disbursed upon achievement of a minimum merit level of 40 credits to be completed by 10/08/2027.

Scholarships are revoked for students enrolled in the first year of degree courses who by 30/11/2027 have not yet achieved the 40 credits and will be required to repay the amount paid with the first installment (equal to 50% of the total value of the Scholarship).



#### b. Second-year students - Level I Academic Diploma Course:

The first instalment of the Scholarship (equal to 50% of the total), **subject to the regular remittance of funds to Istituto Secoli by the Lombardy Region**, will be paid to the eligible beneficiaries (eligible students) by 31/12/2026.

The second instalment of the Scholarship will be disbursed upon achievement of a minimum merit level of 100 credits to be achieved by 10/08/2027.

Five bonus points may be used to achieve this requirement.

The Scholarship is revoked for students enrolled in the second year of degree courses who have not yet achieved 100 credits by 30/11/2027 and will be required to repay the amount paid in the first instalment (equal to 50% of the total value of the Scholarship).

#### c. Third-year students - Level I Academic Diploma Course:

The first instalment of the Scholarship (equal to 50% of the total), **subject to the regular remittance of funds to Istituto Secoli by the Lombardy Region**, will be paid to the eligible beneficiaries (eligible students) by 31/12/2026.

The second instalment of the Scholarship will be disbursed upon achievement of a minimum merit level of 160 credits to be achieved by 10/08/2027.

Twelve bonus points may be used to achieve this requirement.

The Scholarship is revoked for students enrolled in the second year of degree courses who have not yet achieved 100 credits by 30/11/2027 and will be required to repay the amount paid in the first instalment (equal to 50% of the total value of the Scholarship).

In the event that the person concerned does not collect the awarded scholarship amounts by 15/12/2027, he/she will lose the right to receive the monetary amount, but will retain the benefits associated with being a Scholarship recipient.

Eligible applicants will receive their bursary payments with:

- credited to a bank account in their name or co-owned by them;
- rechargeable card with IBAN CODE (e.g. Postepay Evolution) in their name or co-owned by them.

Each claimant is therefore responsible for communicating his or her bank reference details to the DSU Office of Istituto Secoli no later than 15/12/2027.

The allocation of Study Grants to foreign students who are citizens of non-EU countries is carried out in compliance with the Lombardy regional provisions set out in Decree no. 21650 of 13/11/2002 of the Director General of the Education, Training and Labour Directorate.

In particular, the number of scholarships to be allocated to students enrolled in the first year of all study courses is as follows:

- 67% for interested parties who are citizens of EU States;
- 33% for interested parties who are nationals of non-EU States.

NB: The number of credits required must be calculated with reference to the year of first ABSOLUTE ENROLLMENT, i.e. with reference to the first year in which the student enrolled at any University/Academy, either in Italy or abroad. Taking into account the year of absolute first enrolment, students enrolled in years subsequent to the first will also be considered as students enrolling in the first year of Level I Academic Diploma courses following a change of University, School or course of study. In such cases, the number of credits recognised by the Academic Board by the date of payment of the second instalment of the Scholarship shall be taken into consideration.

### 11) INCOMPATIBILITY AND DISQUALIFICATION

The bursary cannot be combined with similar forms of financial aid, including private ones, granted by Istituto Secoli or other public or private bodies, with study grants, however they are granted, by universities or other institutions pursuant to legislative decree 68/2012, with study grants for foreigners granted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, with free places in colleges, residences or boarding schools not managed by Istituto Secoli: in such cases the student may opt for one or the other benefit. In the event of partial gratuitousness, the study grant is proportional.



The person concerned forfeits his or her right to the grant if he or she:

- incurs disciplinary sanctions more serious than written censure for offences committed against Istituto Secoli;
- does not submit to Istituto Secoli, within the time limits that will be indicated to them, any original documentation required for the verification of the truthfulness of the self-certifications produced, or does not consent to or in any case obstructs or eludes, even through negligence, the performance of the truthfulness checks provided for in Article 71, paragraph 4, of Presidential Decree 445/2000;
- applies to drop out or transfer to another university during the 2026/2027 academic year.

## 12) TRANSFER

Students who have transferred from another university after the beginning of the 2026/2027 academic year must ask the Right to Study Management Body of their university of origin to automatically transmit to Istituto Secoli the application they submitted to that university, provided it was submitted within the deadlines set out in the call for applications of that university. The regularisation of the transfer must be completed before the publication of the final ranking list by Istituto Secoli. Admission to the ranking list prepared is subject to possession of the merit and income requirements defined by Istituto Secoli and to the availability of resources on its part.

In the case of transfer to another University after the beginning of the 2026/2027 academic year, the student may ask the DSU Office of Istituto Secoli by 27/11/2026 to forward the application submitted to the University to which the student is transferring. In this case the student forfeits the right to access the study grant provided by Istituto Secoli.

## 13) VERIFICATION OF ECONOMIC CONDITIONS AND TRUTHFULNESS OF ECONOMIC INFORMATION PROVIDED

*(d.p.r. 445/2000, art. 71, comma 4)*

With reference to the determination of the economic conditions for access to the benefits, Istituto Secoli will only accept certifications issued by the competent bodies or substitute declarations accompanied by the express consent referred to in Article no. 71, paragraph 4 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and supplements and will carry out, in accordance with the law, the consequent actions to verify and check the declarations of the interested parties:

- automatic checks on persons belonging to households declaring zero income;
- spot checks on 20% of those eligible for DSU benefits.

The outcome of these checks may result in the cancellation of the benefits unjustly assigned, after appropriate verification processes have been carried out to ascertain the reasons for the discrepancy between tax declarations and declarations for access to DSU benefits. In addition, in the event of untruthful declarations, the sanctions provided for in Articles no. 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000 will be applied, as well as the sanctions provided for in Article no. 10 of Legislative Decree no. 68/2012, consisting in the payment of a sum three times the amount used, the loss of the right to obtain other benefits for the entire duration of the course of study, without prejudice to the adoption of disciplinary sanctions and the reporting to the competent judicial authority to investigate any criminal offences.

## 14) INFORMATION ON THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA AND THE RIGHTS OF THE DECLARANT

*(pursuant to Art. 13 of the Data Protection Regulation EU/2016/679 - so-called GDPR)*
